- Along with functionality development, I enjoyed taking **Azure** work such as creating/managing **deployment pipelines**, **releases**, creating and deploying various **NPM** and **NuGet packages** in private registries and managing **Azure services**.
- Besides the usual development tasks, I have personally **taught** a junior frontend developer **Angular**, common build + deployment flows, **SCRUM**, **Git** and common usage of development tools. By the time the training session ended, she was able to carry out medium-easy tasks alone, create pull requests and do research to find solutions.
